# The Order of Worship

## Bells - Opening Prayer

Opening Hymn: 512 - *O Christ, Our True and Only Light*

## Invocation:

P: We begin our service in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

C: **Amen.**

## Confession and Absolution: *(Taken from Psalm 32)*

P: Blessed is the one whose transgression is forgiven, whose sin is covered. Blessed is the man against whom the LORD counts no iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no deceit.

C: ***For when I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long. For day and night Your hand was heavy upon me; my strength was dried up as by the heat of summer. I acknowledged my sin to You, and I did not cover my iniquity; I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD," and You forgave the iniquity of my sin. Therefore let everyone who is godly offer prayer to you at a time when you may be found; surely in the rush of great waters, they shall not reach him. You are a hiding place for me; you preserve me from trouble; you surround me with shouts of deliverance.***

P: I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with my eye upon you. Be not like a horse or a mule, without understanding, which must be curbed with bit and bridle, or it will not stay near you. Many are the sorrows of the wicked,

C: ***But steadfast love surrounds the one who trusts in the LORD.***

P: As a called servant of God I announce His grace unto you, and by the command of my Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, I forgive all your sins in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Therefore the Psalmist declares: "Be glad in the LORD and rejoice, you righteous; and shout for joy, all you upright in heart!"

***All: Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! Serve the LORD with gladness; Come before His presence with singing. For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, And His truth endures to all generations. Amen. (Psalm 100)***

## The Gloria: *(tune of Hymn 39; written by: Dr. Karl G. Kretzmann in 1929)*

C: ♪ ***Praise to the FATHER Almighty, the Lord of creation, Praise Him, you people, who made you His own holy nation. Joyfully sing, Daughters and sons of the King, Voicing your glad adoration.***

***Praise to the SAVIOR, the Church's eternal Foundation, Heaven and earth are united in His incarnation, And by His cross He hath retrieved all our loss, Saved us from death and damnation.***

***Praise to the SPIRIT, the Author of sanctification, Who by the Gospel assures us of justification, And makes us free, God's blessed children to be, Heirs of eternal salvation. ♪***

## Scripture Reading: *1 Peter 2:6-10 (NKJV)*

<sup>6</sup> Therefore it is also contained in the Scripture, "Behold, I lay in Zion A chief cornerstone, elect, precious, And he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame." <sup>7</sup> Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected Has become the chief cornerstone," <sup>8</sup> and "A stone of stumbling And a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed. <sup>9</sup> But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light; <sup>10</sup> who once were not a people but are now the people of God, who had not obtained mercy but now have obtained mercy.

<sup>16</sup> "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. <sup>17</sup> For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. <sup>18</sup> He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

**Confession of Faith: The Apostles' Creed**

***thence He shall come to judge the quick and the dead.***

***I believe in the Holy Ghost; The holy Christian Church, The communion of saints; The forgiveness of sins; The resurrection of the body; And the life everlasting. Amen.***

13 "You are the salt of the earth; but if the salt loses its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? It is then good for nothing but to be thrown out and trampled underfoot by men. 14 You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."
